The new building will have net-zero carbon emissions. The architecture firm with whom we are working, Ewers Architecture, specializes in sustainability and only works with clients committed to creating net-zero structures.

VISION STATEMENT 7: FOR NORTHERN COLORADO

We do the work to make Unitarian Universalism accessible to all in Northern Colorado.



In addition to the new sanctuary substantially increasing our seating capacity, the building expansion will create new meeting rooms and social spaces (the Entry and Social Hall) that both make our space more inviting and allow us to lend or rent space to local groups and community partners.
